Janie's Jottings ~

I've been hearing that some people are wondering about my role here among you, so I want to explain a bit about Interim or Transitional Ministry. It has been known for some time that the time between regular settled ministries is often a rich time for assessing where a church is at and discerning a path forward. But just as I was beginning to get to know you, we were affected by the need to "socially distance" and I have been wondering how best to move ahead. I am so thankful to Cissy both for the "Coffee with the Pastor" times as well as all of her conversations with church members about their thoughts about the future. So, many thanks for all your work Cissy! Many thoughtful comments have been shared and some good questions asked too. I know that sometimes when we feel stuck, we tend to not consider all the options. So there have been some questions I've wanted to ask too – not so much about staying in the building or options for leaving but 'what is most important to you about being part of a church?' Perhaps thinking about what have been the most meaningful events in your faith journey and how are they connected to the church? I know these are questions that may be easier to address when we can be together again, but perhaps you have some time now to contemplate them now. If you are willing to share your thoughts I'd love to hear them.

I know there are some people who want to consider a future faith leader for the church. That is part of the work we need to do during this Interim time. Before you can search for a new pastor there needs to be consideration of where you hope to be going in the future, and not just the "wishlist" of bringing in new young families, etc. Some have expressed skepticism about finding someone who would come to a "smaller" church. I know you may not appeal to a "big name" but I know there are pastors who would welcome the opportunity to come to your church – a church of caring people. I also remember when Keith Lockhart came to

lead the Utah Symphony. I had wondered why he'd come to Utah from Boston, but then heard from him the wonderful things about Salt Lake from his perspective. Maybe some of you are not remembering some of the great things about this place you live?

One final note for today – several people have suggested I lead a Bible Study. Let's start out meeting on Thursday's at 10:00 am via Zoom. I'd like to begin looking at Luke/ Acts. Please let me know if you're interested either by email or contacting Kristi so I can send you a ZOOM link.

Outreach Recipients for the Summer Months

For the months of June and July, we will be collecting financial donations for the Utah Food Bank. The Food Bank acts as a central distribution point for food pantries across the State serving 150 partner agencies. Founded in 1904, Utah Food Bank has operated under various names, but has always remained true to their mission of *Fighting Hunger Statewide*. In previous times, it is estimated that 382,000 Utahns, which equates to 1 in 8 individuals, are at risk of missing a meal on any given day. Even more alarming is that 1 in 7 Utah kids are unsure where their next meal is coming from. With the pandemic, many people are out of work and rely on the Food Bank and Food Pantries to provide them with needed food for themselves and their families.

With support from the community last year, they distributed 43.3 million pounds of food; the equivalent of 36.1 million meals, to people facing hunger across the state. During the summer months, many school aged children go hungry as they are not in school to receive breakfasts/lunches, and do not have food sent home with them from school based pantries on Fridays that help to feed their families over the weekend.
